We met with Faith Masupa Kalungia, MoMF's founder and CEO, and asked what inspired her to start the NGO.

MoMF has acquired land in the Kabangwe area of Lusaka, where they plan to build a home for children to grow up in, surrounded by love and support.

In the first phase of construction, we, along with other companies, will sponsor and drill a borehole to provide a reliable supply of fresh, clean water—essential not only for the future home but also for construction to begin. We've committed to pledging 29,000 Kwacha (just over \$1,000) to fund this critical step, as without water, the building work cannot commence.

Once the borehole is operational, we'll contact other corporates, insurers, and clients, to partner with us in moving the building phase forward.
